Introduction

Besides all the things mentioned above, travelling has given me the knowledge of history of many countries. For example, knowing that a lot of Afro-Americans were colonized by England to America helps to find out about unstable conditions. They can be connected to racial contradictions. It can be



an important factor to realize the purpose by looking at the possible conflicts. While being in the South Africa, it was possible to become familiar with the economic, social, and political conditions. Realizing that the unemployment rate in the South Africa is very high, over 25%, and noticing that country has been destroyed by crime and bad investments helps to build up a clear picture of the diplomacy, look deeper at the problem, try to find more appropriate ways to improve the diplomatic skills. It gives chances to understand possible and current hot spots in the international relations, and find ways to solve the problems.

When dealing with international representatives, one should not forget about religion. While visiting India, I have noticed that one-third of Indians prefer to eat vegetarian food due to their religion, Buddhism. In Muslim countries, it is banned not expose intimate parts of the body. These things should be taken into consideration, especially when communicating or, for instance, asking for a dinner someone who is vegetarian due to religious views.

Everyone who conducts negotiations with international partners cannot succeed if he/she does not understand a language and cannot be understood by foreigners. Travelling abroad gives a great experience when it comes to practising one's communication skills. Being in different corners of the world makes a person familiar with local accents. Some experience that is also essential is saving people in emergency situations. When travelling to Mexico, I experienced the Hurricane Wilma, therefore, I learned how to survive a hurricane. Nobody knows what one has to wait for. A person who works with international organizations and visits places with the danger of natural disasters should know what he/she has to do in case of contingencies.
